

Good morning, PreCalculus parents and students. I hope this email finds you well.

As we wind down the semester, I want to make sure everyone is aware of our remaining assessments, assignments and deadlines.

1. Please make sure you're aware of your/your child's current grade in the class. Please email me with any questions about overall grades going into our last days together.
2. We have two major grades left in the class: Monday's 'Survey of Functions and Logarithms' test and the final exam.
3. As discussed in class, each student should have all assignments pertaining to our Algebra review unit (survey of functions and logarithms) completed by tomorrow, May 10th. This includes the test review. All assignments and resources can be found on my website. Hard copies are available in my classroom.
4. Students will be given the opportunity to replace their lowest test grade with their final exam grade if and only if they complete each problem on the final exam review on time.
5. The final exam review is posted on the front page of my website.
6. Due dates for the final exam review: Unit 10 test review (I'll check it again for those who didn't complete it by Friday, May 10; this time for bonus points) – Tuesday, May 14th. Unit 8, 9 – Wednesday, May 15th. Unit 6, 7 – Thursday, May 16th. Unit 5 – Friday, May 17th.
7. As an additional bonus, I will add two bonus points to each student's final exam grade for each chunk of the review they complete. (2 points for May 14, 2 points for May 15, 2 points for May 16, and 2 points for May 17). Points will only be rewarded if each chunk is 100% complete with all work shown with an obvious intent for accuracy. If a student thoroughly prepare(s) for the final exam, he/she can earn up to a 108 on the final exam and replace his/her lowest test grade with the final exam grade.
8. Students are expected to rely on their notes, assignments and each other to make sure they're able to accurately complete the material.
