- 1. Please make sure you're aware of your/your child's current grade in the class. Please email me with any questions about overall grades going into our last days together.
- 2. We have two <u>major</u> grades left in the class: Monday's 'Survey of Functions and Logarithms' test and the final exam.
- 3. As discussed in class, each student should have <u>all</u> assignments pertaining to our Algebra review unit (survey of functions and logarithms) completed by tomorrow, May 10<sup>th</sup>. This includes the test review. All assignments and resources can be found on my website. Hard copies are available in my classroom.
- 4. Students will be given the opportunity to replace their lowest test grade with their final exam grade <u>if and only if</u> they complete each problem on the final exam review on time.
- 5. The final exam review is posted on the front page of my website.
- 6. Due dates for the final exam review: Unit 10 test review (I'll check it again for those who didn't complete it by Friday, May 10; this time for bonus points) Tuesday, May 14<sup>th</sup>. Unit 8, 9 Wednesday, May 15<sup>th</sup>. Unit 6, 7 Thursday, May 16<sup>th</sup>. Unit 5 Friday, May 17<sup>th</sup>.
- 7. As an additional bonus, I will add two bonus points to each student's final exam grade for each chunk of the review they complete. (2 points for May 14, 2 points for May 15, 2 points for May 16, and 2 points for May 17). Points will only be rewarded if each chunk is 100% complete with all work shown with an obvious intent for accuracy. If a student thoroughly prepare(s) for the final exam, he/she can earn up to a 108 on the final exam and replace his/her lowest test grade with the final exam grade.
